PARENTS SACRAMENT CONFIRMATION AGREEMENT

I confirm that I have read the following carefully and understand that by attending the confirmation programme, I agree for my child to the terms, conditions, and policies established by the Confirmation Planning Team, the youth minister, and the leaders of the Catholic Parish of New Plymouth.

- 1. I agree that my child should follow the youth minister's and leaders' rules and instructions.
- 2. I understand that my child must act responsibly. If he or she is involved in a serious disciplinary issue or engages in unacceptable behaviour that puts themselves or others at risk, I accept that they may be asked to leave. In such cases, I may be contacted. If this happens at Camp, I acknowledge that as the Parent/Guardian, I will be required to either collect my child or arrange their transportation home.
- 3. If my child needs to leave a session or the camp due to unforeseen circumstances, I will inform the youth minister or designated adult and sign them out. I will ensure that the responsible adult has either spoken with me or received written communication from me as the Parent/Guardian, granting permission for my child to leave.
- 4. I understand that the Catholic Parish of New Plymouth will not accept responsibility for lost, stolen, or damaged personal property; therefore, my child must look after themselves and their belongings.
- 5. I understand that I can ask the youth minister and leaders any questions regarding the activities my child will participate in. I recognise that participation in these activities is voluntary and follows a challenge-by-choice model. I also understand that my child can withdraw from an activity if they feel uncomfortable or at risk by simply informing the youth minister.
- 6. I give my permission for the Catholic Parish of New Plymouth to take photos and videos of my child and use them for promotional purposes and in newsletters. If I change my mind, I will inform my child so they can communicate with the youth minister and request to be excluded from group photos.
