ASCENSION of the LORD



Dear Parishioners,

This Sunday is the solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord. Jesus ascending to the Father entrusts to his missional disciples the work of worship, service of the poor and evangelisation. Jesus places value on humanity and our ability to lean into the power of the Holy Spirit and act as agents to produce fruit for the kingdom.

Evangelisation - A key part of "fruit" is to make disciples of Jesus Christ. Missional disciples who hear the call to go, to be sent to transform the lives of many who seek what Jesus Christ proposes. This is what we are doing with Alpha. Our parish family is currently hosting 64 people to a meal, a modern video presentation of the Gospel, and a small group discussion on what was heard. We place our guests on the doorstep of the Holy Spirit, expose them to the irresistible risen Jesus, and surround them with the faith family. We have so much to offer. It is not what we want from them, it is what we want for them.

We serve the poor - with the tremendous community dinners on Tuesday evenings. The parish with the amazing work of St Vincent de Paul Society - the shop, the furniture and food deliveries, accommodation help, below the radar work, all serves those in need.

We worship God - with right praise at every Sunday gathering for the Eucharist.

In our March update we advised that the CPNP has made a request to the Toi Foundation (formerly TSB Community Trust) for financial assistance for the position of Fund-raising Specialist. We are pleased to report that the Toi Foundation has generously granted the Parish \$15,000 towards the funding of the Fundraiser position.

The Steering Committee view the generosity of the Toi Foundation as the initial seeding for the important task of fundraising that is before us. Expressions of interest are now invited from parishioners who believe they have the skills, talents, and time to be considered for this key parish role. It is envisaged this will be a contracted part-time position for 2-3 years. The position will be competitively remunerated.

The evening began with a delicious meal catered by the Bzee Beez, followed by the Alpha video - "Who is Jesus?" Guests then moved into their small group. Some great questions were asked - If you had a chance to meet Jesus, how would you feel and what would you say to him? Another question – What do you think about Jesus? How do you feel about Him? Some great questions to think about for the week ahead! Thank you to all the Alpha guests, Bzee Beez and the Alpha Team.

Mary is known by 26 powerful titles, 2 of which we reflected on last week.



This week, we honour Mary as the Mother of the Church - when Mary was called during the Annuncia-

tion, she gave her consent to the coming messianic kingdom, which would ultimately be the formation of the Church. She was also present with the apostles praying in the upper room when the Holy Spirit descended on them, giving birth to the new Church here on Earth. Each member of the Body of Christ is a part of her Son, and she wraps us in her mantle and protects us from evil.

Mother of Divine Grace - Mary received distinctive blessings so that she could be the most fitted mother for Christ, this includes her Immaculate Conception, her spiritual motherhood of all Christians, and Assumption into heaven. She is Full of Grace because she was saved before birth, whereas we are saved after we are baptized with the Holy Spirit.

Mirror of Justice - Just as a mirror reflects your image, Mary was the reflection of Jesus, the one who came to justify us all. Justice is the perfect state of the soul, completion of all virtues. And just as a clean, flawless mirror reflects a perfect image, she reflected the virtues of Jesus perfectly.
