Dear Parishioners,

Our parish mission is to transform lives empowered by the Holy Spirit. This is our new model - a missional parish identity.

The cultural climate in NZ and the western world has shifted. For parishes it is no longer business as usual. It is important that we know what we are about, where we are heading, and how we are going to get there. Strategies that once worked in a parish no longer work. For example, children do not necessarily catch faith from their parents and grandparents. Although we hope that this will still happen!

Families celebrating baptism, First Holy Communion and Confirmation do not necessarily form a profound relationship with Jesus Christ and the parish family.

Many parishioners have left and are probably not returning. Strategies are called for that actively evangelize. Strategies for curious adults that propose Jesus Christ as Saviour, that surround them with the parish family, and place these people on the doorstep of the Holy Spirit.

We currently run Alpha as our tool to evangelize. We have 74 guests attending. Please pray for them and the parishioners who are helping to run Alpha.

We have 60 young people preparing to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation on Sunday evening 30 June. The Evangelization of these young people is at the heart of the Confirmation preparation.

We have 31 older children to be baptised this Sunday. Their parents have been invited to come to Alpha - about half of them said yes and are at Alpha now! The parents of 79 children preparing for First Reconciliation and Communion have also been invited to Alpha. It is amazing that we are doing this!

FR TRUNG AND FR SIMON AWAY IN JUNE

In our March update we advised that the CPNP has made a request to the Toi Foundation (formerly TSB Community Trust) for financial assistance for the position of Fundraising Specialist. Our Blessed Mother is called The Ark of the Covenant because she was the precious vessel that carried the promise, or covenant of God, to Abraham. Just as God dwelt inside the Ark of the Covenant that was carried by the Levites, so Jesus was carried by the new Ark of the Covenant - the womb of Mary. Another title for Mary is the Gate of Heaven. Jesus told us that we can only get to the Father through the Son, but Jesus had to get to us through his Mother, Mary. Therefore, she is called the "Gate of Heaven" because she delivered Jesus to us.

Mary is the Morning Star. Just as the "morning star" shines brightly before the sun rises, so too, Mary as Mother of Jesus, is the morning star preceding the birth of her son who is the Light of the World.
