Over the years, in India, I have served in various capacities, including as a Parish Priest, Assistant Director of Social work, Seminary formator, Vocation promoter and Principal of various Schools. These experiences have enriched my priestly min-



istry and strengthened my commitment to serve God and His people.

In last October, I arrived here in the Palmerston North Diocese, and for the past three months, I have been serving at the Holy Spirit Cathedral in Palmerston North. I feel blessed to be part of this vibrant faith community. I look forward to journeying with you in faith, praying together, celebrating the Holy Eucharist, and growing closer to Christ as one Parish family. I entrust my priestly ministry among you to the Maternal care of Blessed Virgin Mother Mary. Please keep me in your prayers, as I assure you of mine. I am eager to meet each one of you and journey together in prayer, faith and service.

PROM POPE FRANCIS

Pope Francis' prayer intention for the month of February is for the terminally ill. "Let us pray that the terminally ill and their families always receive the necessary medical and human care and assistance."

FEAST OF THE PRESENTATION OF THE LORD:

This Sunday 2nd February we celebrate the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord. Forty days after Christmas, the Church celebrates this feast day, an event that the Evangelist Luke recounts in Chapter 2 of his Gospel. In the East, the celebration of this feast dates back to the 4th century.



Around the middle of the 5th century, we know the feast was celebrated in Rome. At this time it was called *The Feast of the Meeting of the Lord* because Jesus enters the Temple and "meets" the priests, as well as Simeon and Anna, representatives of the people of God.

It is in that holy encounter with the prophet Simeon and Anna that Jesus' divinity was manifested by a human prophet for the first time. Anna, the prophetess came forward and "gave thanks to God and spoke about the child to all those who were awaiting the redemption of Jerusalem". At a certain point, the blessing of candles was added to this feast to recall that Jesus is the "light to the Gentiles". Thus, this feast is also sometimes referred to as Candlemas Day.




let us know in the office if you would like us to save you a copy.


