The countdown to Open House is on. Only two weeks to go to this nation wide event, in our parish, starting Friday 22nd November 4.30pm and concluding Saturday 23 November 4.00pm.

Other parishes in the 6 Dioceses have had an opportunity to register, now it is our turn. Now we parishioners can register (online) and be part of this amazing two days. Be part of the sharing of experiences of our journey, and hearing of the journey of others.

If parishioners would like to register for Open House, you are more than welcome. We want you to be there. Your presence is part of showing the wider Catholic community who we are, and what we are doing. Register and see what it is all about. The cost is \$85, and this gives entry to all sessions of the two days & all meals.

We are starting Friday afternoon at 4.30pm with the Welcome and Mass presided by Bishop John Adams. His keynote speech, THE CASE FOR RENEWAL will be delivered during Mass. This will be followed after Mass by the second keynote speech by liturgist Msgr Trevor Murray – THE PRIMACY OF EVANGELISATION.

Saturday 23rd starts at 6.00am (*for the hearty*) with a walk along the walkway. For others, we begin with 8.30am Mass presided by Bishop Michael Gielen of Christchurch, and go on to a day of keynote speeches, Break out sessions (workshops), panel discussions, Praise and Worship & more. Not forgetting home baking for morning tea made by parish cooks (showing our famed parish hospitality) and a delicious catered lunch.

Saturday Keynote speakers are: Cheryl Surrey, from Divine Renovation -BEST OF LEADERSHIP Bishop Gielen – THE POWER OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

All our events are at our St Joseph's church and the hall or in two adjoining buildings which have been lent to us for the days. This makes it all very easy to get to.

Open House is on the home page. Just click on the image and it will take you to the registration page. It's really simple. We encourage parishioners to register for this great event, part of our missional journey, part of implementing our Vision.

If you do not wish to register, parishioners will be able to attend Mass on Friday night and to hear those keynote speakers, concluding for you with Adoration about 7.00pm. Registered participants will then go on to the catered dinner in the hall. If you want to be part of Saturday's programme after 8.30am Mass you will need to register. Jubilee 2025

Pope Francis has declared 2025 as a year of Jubilee with the theme 'Pilgrims of Hope', giving voice to his desire for the year to foster a greater sense of global sisterhood and brotherhood, solidarity with the poor, and caring for the environment. He invites the Church – the men and women of our time, and above all young people – to rediscover the theme of hope.

The Jubilee 2025 will officially open on 24 December 2024, at 7.00pm (Rome Time) with a Mass presided over by Pope Francis in St. Peter's Square. The rite of the Opening of the Holy Door will follow.

The Holy Doors, present in each of the four papal basilicas in Rome, are destination points for pilgrims who travel to Rome during the Jubilee and who pass through seeking special graces and outpourings of God's mercy. The last Ordinary Jubilee was the *Great Jubilee of 2000,* celebrated by Pope John Paul II.

In Romans 12:1, St. Paul urges Christians to "offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God." This invitation calls us to consecrate our entire lives to God, not only in prayer but through every action, service, and encounter in our daily lives. By offering ourselves in this way, we



the faithful unite with the Paschal Mystery – the suffering, death, and resurrection of Christ – each time we participate in the Mass. Through this act, we embrace the crosses and challenges that life presents. Our struggles, joys, sufferings, heartbreaks, sorrows, and relationships all become part of our spiritual worship, a gift of ourselves made holy and pleasing to God.

SACRED HEART PARISH, INGLEWOOD, PROPERTY REDEVELOPMENT

Sacred Heart Parish in Inglewood are looking at the possibility of redeveloping some of the property that they own.
