What is Divine Renovation (DR) Open House?

DR Open House (we just call it Open House) is an event hosted by a parish implementing the Divine Renovation's principles of missional renewal. Open House is held all over the world. On 22 and 23 November this is US. We are as parish in partnership with the Diocese of Palmerston North and Divine Renovation, hosting OPEN HOUSE.

In 2022, 11 staff members and parishioners went to Taupo parish, who were hosting of one the first Open House events in New Zealand. For our parish, this was a major step in our journey of missional renewal. In Taupo, we saw how their parish was pursuing the mission of God. And now it is our turn to show others what we are doing & what we are planning.

For us, OPEN HOUSE is a two day event, starting Friday, 22 November and finishing 4.00pm Saturday, 23 November. Registrations are open to all parishes, all Catholics through out the country. We have registrations from Auckland to Christchurch, but at this stage largely from those of the Diocese of Palmerston North.

In our OPEN HOUSE, we will be sharing stories of what we have learnt in our journey, and encouraging others by sharing the hope, the ideas, the insights, of what is possible. This will be presented in Masses, ongoing Adoration, key note addresses, breakout sessions (workshops), discussion, reflection time, praise and worship, testimonies, slide shows. and wonderful hospitality. We also have several speakers from other parishes who have worked with Divine Renovation. They are further down the road than us, so we and others, will learn from their experiences. Our Bishop John Adams, and Bishop Michael Gielen from Christchurch Diocese will be two key note speakers.

If parishioners would like to help, our request to all parishioners is; "Please join us in prayer". Come Holy Spirit. If you would like to help by offering your services on Friday, 22 and/or Saturday, 23 November, we have roles in hospitality and cleaning on that day. We also still need promises of garden cut flowers for posies and the floral arrangements. And this week's special request is for home baking for the morning and afternoon teas.
