RITE OF CHRISTIAN OF INITIATION FOR ADULTS

Rite of Christian of Initiation for Adults, commonly referred to as RCIA is the process for adults to enter the Catholic Church. In our parish 17 adults are being accompanied in the RCIA process by their sponsors and the Parish RCIA team. 13 Catechumens are discerning their readiness for the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Holy Eucharist and 4 Candidates for Full Communion into Catholic Church.



During RCIA, we explored the teachings of Christ as revealed in the Scriptures, the Church's teaching authority (i.e. Magisterium) and her living Tradition. Much time is spent on the 7 Sacraments and how these Sacraments are sources of God's love, mercy and grace and are essential for our faith journey. In availing ourselves to the Sacraments, and animated by the Holy Spirit, we can be drawn into a deeper union with God and his Church.

At each RCIA session, Catechumens, Candidates and respective Sponsors have an opportunity to respond to reflective questions and share how their faith impacts their lives everyday.

In the coming weeks, Catechumens and Candidates will be participating in various Liturgical Rites with us. These include Rite of Election, Celebration of the Sacraments of Initiation and Sunday Masses. These are great opportunities to welcome them and make yourself know to them


DIVINE MERCY CONFERENCE IN AUCKLAND May 23-25 2025 Fr Chris Alar - Keynote Speaker






