The first recorded celebration of Christmas, or the feast commemorating the birth of Jesus Christ, dates back to the 4th century. The earliest known reference to celebrating Christmas on December 25th is found in a Roman almanac from 336 AD., which lists the date as a Christian festival.

This would have been during the reign of the Roman Emperor Constantine, who was the first Christian Roman Emperor. December 25th was officially declared as the day to celebrate Christ's birth by Pope Julius I in the 4th century. The exact year of the declaration is unknown, but Pope Julius I served as Pope from 337AD to 352 AD, so it is generally believed that this declaration happened sometime during his papacy in the mid-4th century.




